Dear Teachers, Parents and Dancers

On behalf of the Stanley Carroll School we look forward to welcoming you all to the 19th Annual East of England Championships.

We are delighted this year to return again to Orton Longueville School with its excellent facilities. The school itself is situated close to the A1 with easy communications to the North and South of England. We have an impressive set of adjudicators and musicians this year and look forward to a high standard of dancing. We will aim to recall a minimum of 50% of dancers in all open and preliminary championships from Under 10 subject to entry and we are also running a separate open set dance solo competition from Under 10 for those dancers unfortunate enough not to make the open championship recall. There will be 100% recall in Under 6, 7, 8 & 9 Championships (please note recall in Under 8 & 9 is Traditional Set dance).

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners of all novice, primary and intermediate competitions and sashes will be awarded for 1st to 5th places in all Championships and pennants 1st to 3rd in boys championships. **Novice & Primary Grades are open to dancers from all regions.**

We have provided a timetable on the attached syllabus and have very efficient stagehands and they will work hard to keep to time throughout the weekend.

Our catering arrangements are again excellent, providing hot and cold food throughout the weekend in the dining rooms. There will also be a teacher's hospitality room available throughout the weekend serving hot and cold drinks and lunch refreshments. We have also invited Pat Preston and Derry Reel Dancewear, John & Noreen Egan from FeisPix and Wanda to supply wigs and hair pieces over the weekend.

We look forward to meeting you all once again and thank you for your support.

EAST OF ENGLAND CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010 FEIS RULES

General

- 1 Age to be taken from 1st January of the current year.
- 2 Adjudicators decision is final.
- 3 Committee members only may approach adjudicators.
- 4 Any protest against breach of rules must be made in writing to the feis organiser within one hour of conclusion of a competition, with a fee of £10.00. Should the objection be upheld the fee will be refunded.
- 5 Entries will only be accepted from schools registered with An Coimisiun.
- 6 Lodgement of entries at a feis implies that you accept the rules relating to the feis in their entirety as laid down by the An Coimisiún le Rinci Gaelacha & Midland Regional Council.
- 7 Any form of Artificial Carriage Aids are strictly forbidden except for medical reasons.
- 8 Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder or commercial film with or without flash enhancement is expressly forbidden in competition
- 9 Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the under 12 age group.
- 10 A solo competition cannot be held with only 1 competitor

Grades:

- 11 The Novice and Primary Grades are open to dancers from any region.
- 12 In Novice Grades only basic steps are to be performed i.e. no intricate movements, clicks, rocks, twists, etc..
- 13 Competitors must dance in their own age group for solo competitions except where there is no provision for that dance in that age group.
- 14 No competitor may compete twice in the same competition.
- 15 Where there are five or less competitors in a solo competition grades will be unaffected.
- 16 A **Novice** dancer is one who has not won 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in that particular dance in any age group. This includes Trophy Competitions – see rule 19.
- 17 A **Primary** dancer is one who has not won a 1st place for that particular dance in any age group. This includes Trophy Competitions – see rule 19.
- 18 An **Intermediate** dancer is one who has not won a 1st place for that particular dance in his/her present age group.
- 19 In a trophy competition a dancer must have performed their choice of dance in the solo competition.
- 20 The winner of a **Primary** or **Intermediate Trophy** competition must move up to the next grade for that particular dance. In **Novice Trophy** competitions 1st, 2nd & 3rd places must move up to the next grade for that dance.

Figure:

- 21 In Figure and Ceili competitions - rules regarding age and re-dancing apply as laid out by An Coimisiun apply.
- 22 In Ceili 8 Hand competitions any 8 Hand may be performed in accordance with Ar Rince Foirne.

- 23 Figure Championship in the U7's year group may be a 6 hand dance, 8 hand Ceili or Figure Dance of 6 or more
- 24 Mixed and Unmixed Ceili – Rules as laid out by An Coimisiun apply to the Minor, Junior and Senior Ceili competitions - A mixed team must consist of 4 boys and 4 girls.

Championships and Premier competitions:

- 25 Competitors can only dance in either Preliminary or Open Championship; they may not compete in both. Intermediate competitors can dance their grade dances and either the Preliminary or Open Championship.
- 26 IMPORTANT CHANGE TO PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP RULE (MAY 2009) - To compete in a Preliminary Championship a competitor cannot have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open championship or 1st in a Preliminary Championship during the current feis year
- 27 Championship/Premier Competitions - Only Intermediate and Open dancers are eligible to compete (except under 6 and 7 – see below).
- 28 Under 6s & under 7s Championships/Premier must dance Reel & Light Jig. A recall is at the discretion of the feis organisers. All grades are allowed to compete but must have performed these dances on the day of the feis.
- 29 Under 8s and Under 9s must dance Reel and Heavy Jig. A recall is at the discretion of the feis organisers. To be eligible to compete, dancers must perform 2 dances in the solo rounds on the day of the feis.
- 30 Under 10 and up. All dancers should be given a choice of Reel or Slip Jig and Jig or Hornpipe and recall set dance. Subsidiary solos may be run at the discretion of the feis organisers.
- 31 If a minimum number is stated for a championship to be held, then this must be consistent for both mixed and unmixed championships. E.g. if you decide on a minimum number of 5 in order to run a separate boys championship then this must be consistent with the number required to run any championship. This may well be prevalent in the younger age groups where numbers can be low. For example if you have this rule on your syllabus and you only have 4 entries for Under 6 – you should not run the championship. This is in accordance with the sex discrimination act.

FROM THE NORTH

Leave the A1 Southbound at the Alwalton/Chesterton sign.
Go through the village and at T-junction turn left onto Oundle Road. Carry on through 4 roundabouts and the school, which is well signposted, is on the right hand side.

FROM THE SOUTH

A1 Northbound - Ignore junction 17 and continue on A1. 200 yards after the services, leave the A1 signposted Chesterton/Alwalton. At T-junction turn left on to Oundle Road. Carry on through 4 roundabouts and the school, which is well signposted, will be found on the right hand side.

BY TRAIN
